THINGS TO WATCH FOR IN A NEW DAYCARE DOG

SORE PADS

Running amok may be rough on your dog's feet, and they may get sore and abraded pads. This will go away as their pads get thicker and use to running on different surfaces.

SORE MUSCLES

Your dog(s) will be having so much fun playing at Mutt Hutt that they may forget to pace themselves and get sore muscles. Over time this will fade as you see them get stronger and more in shape.

EXHAUSTION

The new social interaction your dog will encounter while being at Mutt Hutt will be both physically and mentally exhausting. Look for your dog to need a lot of rest after daycare. You may even find your pooch crashed out on the ride home.

ENTHUSIASM

Your dogs' enthusiasm to enter the group will grow as they get more used to being at Mutt Hutt. Eventually they will be just as excited to get to daycare as when you pick them up at night.

WET COAT

Your dog's coat may be wet when you pick them up during the summer – on hot summer days they may have been lounging in the pools. Not to worry, the water is changed very frequently to keep them clean and healthy. Drooling may contribute to wet coats. Also anxiety, excitement and even sloppy drinkers can make your pet a wet head!

EXCESSIVE DRINKING

Fresh water is available in all crates, the daycare room, and in the outside play area at all times. If you find that your dog(s) come home very thirsty, it's often due to their excitement and not the lack of water. Dogs often play so hard they might forget to stop and take a drink.
